MEMORANDUM FOR All US Army LDENTAC Enlisted Personnel

SUBJECT: Landstuhl Dental Activity (LDENTAC) Policy Letter 04-18, Reenlistment Policy

1. It is important to the success of the mission, of not only this organization but also the US Army that we ensure every enlisted soldier be given every opportunity to meet eligibility requirements for reenlistment. It is also my policy to ensure that eligible soldiers know their reenlistment options, to include USAR options.
2. To aid the enlisted soldiers of this unit in the reenlistment process, I have designated SGT David Finkelstein as the LDENTAC Reenlistment NCO. He is available for counseling and guidance, as is the First Sergeant. Further, I wish to make it clear that my door is always open to answer questions and provide feedback for your questions concerning reenlistment and possible careers in the US Army.
3. In addition to taking the rest of the workday off, immediately following individual reenlistment, the following incentives are announced for soldiers who reenlist in the Active Duty Army or the Army Reserve:

Reenlist in the USAR = 3 day pass in conjunction with a weekend
Reenlist for any years = 4 day pass
4. Questions, comments and/or concerns may be addressed to anyone in the chain-of-command or NCO support chain to include all mentioned in this Policy.
